Gold mineralisation is within a quartz veined metasediment and is structurally controlled. This drill program was formulated to confirm mineralisation thickness and grade from previous drilling. The historic drill lines are 50m apart with both new drill holes in the section intersecting near-vertical mineralisation approximately 4m in true width.

The company is currently planning a follow-up drill program to infill this shallow, high-grade mineralisation. Infill drilling on 25m line spacing will assess continuity of mineralisation along strike and deeper holes will test open mineralisation at depth.

This drilling program will commence at a date to be advised shortly.
